Dear Parents and Wrestlers,

- Encourage and support your teammates. Always treat teammates and opponents with respect.
- The use of any illegal substance will result in immediate and permanent removal from the team.

# Middle School Athletic Eligibility

## Learning Behavior Criteria:

• Eligibility based on learning behavior grades is typically run Friday afternoon. Any learning behavior grade less than 2 will result in a student-athlete being ineligible to participate in games for the week. For eligibility to be regained, all learning behavior grades must be above 2 when eligibility is run the following Friday.

# Behavioral Criteria:

- OSS the student is prohibited from participating in practice and contests until they have been re-admitted\* to school after fulfilling their suspension.
- ISS the student is prohibited from participating in practice and contests from the moment they are assigned ISS until they have fulfilled their consequence.

## Attendance Criteria:

- Any unexcused (UNX) absence (includes parent verified unexcused absence) during the day prohibits that student from practice and/or contests for that day. A parent verified absence will be evaluated on a case by case situation by the athletic director and or building administrator.

  An UNX on Friday prohibits the student from competition on the weekend.
- Any absence due to illness must be approved by either the athletic director or administration in order to participate in contests.

## Administrative Discretion:

• Administration may use their discretion to establish greater learning behavior expectations for their school than those presented in this process.
